

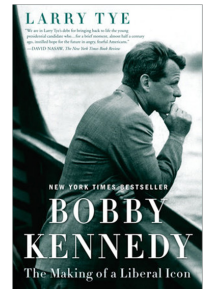

Come hear Author Series Program host, Hank Phillippi Ryan and New York Times Best Selling author, Larry Tye, discuss his noted biography, **Bobby Kennedy: The Making of a Liberal Icon** which explores RFK's extraordinary transformation from cold warrior to fiery leftist.

In addition to his writing, Larry runs the Boston-based Health Coverage Fellowship, which helps the media do a better job reporting on critical issues like public health, mental health, and high-tech medicine. From 1986 to 2001, Tye was an award-winning reporter at The Boston Globe, where his primary beat was medicine. He also served as the Globe's environmental reporter, roving national writer, investigative reporter, and sports writer.

HANK PHILLIPPI RYAN is the on-air investigative reporter for Boston's WHDH-TV. She's won 34 EMMYs, 14 Murrows, and dozens more honors for her ground-breaking journalism. The bestselling author of nine mysteries, Ryan's also an award-winner in her second profession—with five Agathas, two Anthonys, two Macavities, the Daphne, and for *The Other Woman*, the coveted Mary Higgins Clark Award. It is also honored as a Mary Higgins Clark, Daphne and Agatha Award nominee. Hank is a founder of MWA University and 2013 president of National Sisters in Crime.
